WHITE TIGER



**WHITE TIGERS ARE OFTEN CONFUSED WITH SIBERIAN TIGERS, BECAUSE WHEN PEOPLE THINK OF SIBERIA, THEY THINK OF SNOW. WHITE TIGERS ARE WHITE BENGAL TIGERS
THE GENE FOR BLUE EYES IS LINKED TO THE GENE FOR WHITE FUR. SO WHILE MOST ORANGE BENGAL TIGERS HAVE YELLOW EYES, WHITE TIGERS HAVE BLUE EYES
THESE LARGE ANIMALS CAN GROW TO BE MORE THAN TEN FEET LONG!

LIGER

CHEETAH

THE CHEETAH HAS A LONG, STRONG, FLAT TAIL. THIS TAIL WORKS LIKE A RUDDER ON A BOAT. IT HELPS THEM STEER AND KEEP THEIR BALANCE WHEN RUNNING VERY FAST

CHEETAHS DON'T ROAR, THEY MEOW

ELEPHANT

DID YOU KNOW ELEPHANTS CAN GET SUNBURNED? OUCH! THESE GIANTS BATHE IN MUD TO HELP PROTECT THEIR SKIN FROM THE SUN.

GIRAFFE



**GIRAFFES ARE THE TALLEST MAMMAL IN THE WORLD. ...

PYGMY HIPPOPOTAMUS



MEDIAN LIFE EXPECTANCY IS 27 YEARS.

GESTATION: 6 TO 7 MONTHS. NUMBER OF YOUNG AT BIRTH: USUALLY 1, SOMETIMES 2. ...

THEIR NOSTRILS CLOSE, AND THEY CAN HOLD THEIR BREATH FOR FIVE MINUTES OR LONGER WHEN SUBMERGED

FUN FACTS. A PYGMY HIPPO CALF CAN NURSE FROM ITS MOTHER ON LAND OR UNDERWATER.

GREVY'S ZEBRA



MOST FAMOUSLY, ZEBRAS HAVE BLACK AND WHITE STRIPES. GREVY'S ARE THE LARGEST OF ALL ZEBRAS, AND THEY HAVE LONG NECKS WITH PROMINENT, ERECT MANES. THEY HAVE THE LARGEST EARS OF ANY ZEBRA SPECIES, AND THEIR LONG, NARROW HEADS GIVE THEM A MULE-LIKE APPEARANCE.

WATERBUCK



**MALES ARE GENERALLY ABOUT 25% LARGER THAN THE FEMALES
ONLY MALES HAVE HORNS
DESPITE ITS NAME, THE WATERBUCK IS NOT ACTUALLY AQUATIC. RATHER, THEY ARE FREQUENTLY
FOUND IN THE VICINITY OF RIVERS AND LAKES. THEY WILL OFTEN VENTURE INTO THE WATER TO ESCAPE
PREDATORS**

BARBARY SHEEP



THE BARBARY SHEEP HAS A LONG, VERTICAL FRINGE OF HAIR EXTENDING FROM THE THROAT REGION TO THE UPPER PART OF THE FRONT LEGS. IT ALSO HAS LONG BACK-CURVED HORNS. MALE: THE HORNS OF MALES ARE SLIGHTLY LONGER THAN THOSE OF FEMALES

IMPALA



THEY ARE FLEET RUNNERS WHO CAN LEAP UP TO 10M IN LENGTH AND 3M IN HEIGHT. THEY USE THEIR TREMENDOUS SPEED AND AGILITY TO AVOID PREDATION, AND SEEMINGLY FOR PURE ENJOYMENT. MALES ARE KNOWN AS RAMS, WHILE FEMALES ARE REFERRED TO AS EWES AND HAVE NO HORNS.

SABLE ANTELOPE



WEIGHT. 220 TO 238 KILOGRAMS (485 TO 525 POUNDS)

SIZE. 116 TO 142 CENTIMETERS IN HEIGHT (45 TO 56 INCHES)

LIFE SPAN - UP TO 16 YEARS IN THE WILD; UP TO 20 YEARS IN CAPTIVITY.

SABLE CONGREGATE IN HERDS OF 15 TO 20 INDIVIDUALS WITH MATRIARCHAL SOCIAL STRUCTURE.

WITHIN THE GROUP, THE MORE DOMINANT FEMALE IS THE LEADER. THERE IS ONLY ONE ADULT MALE (CALLED A BULL) IN EACH HERD.

BLUE WILDEBEEST



**BLUE WILDEBEEST GOT NAME AS THEIR COAT HAS A BLUE SHEEN.
THERE ARE AROUND 1.5 MILLION LIVING IN THE SERENGETI ALONE! THEY ARE WIDESPREAD IN MANY
AREAS OF AFRICA.
THEIR MAIN DEFENSE FROM PREDATORS IS LIVING IN A GROUP. ...
THEY CAN RUN UP TO 40 MPH, WHICH IS PRETTY FAST!**

MOUFLON



THE MOUFLON IS A WILD SHEEP NATIVE TO IRAN AND OTHER COUNTRIES IN THE NEAR EAST. ITS CURVING HORNS CAN BE ALMOST THREE FEET LONG & GROW THROUGHOUT ITS LIFE!

BENEATH THEIR EYES, MOUFLON HAVE LARGE GLANDS, WHICH OFTEN RELEASE A STICKY SUBSTANCE THAT MATS THEIR WOOL.

A MOUFLON HAS MUSCULAR LEGS AND A STOCKY BODY, WHICH HELPS IT TO MOVE ABOUT STEEP TERRAINS.

LECHWE



YOUNG LECHWE ARE CALLED LAMBS, WITH ADULT MALES ARE CALLED RAMS AND FEMALES EWES. THEIR HIND LEGS ARE LONGER AND MORE POWERFUL THAN THE FRONT LEGS, HELPING THEM TO MAKE HUGE LEAPS THROUGH THE WATERY OR MARSHY TERRAIN.

LECHWE ARE GRACEFUL ANTELOPES FOUND IN WETLANDS OF SOUTH-CENTRAL AFRICA. THEY ARE GOLDEN BROWN IN COLOR WITH WHITE BELLIES. MALES ARE DARKER THAN FEMALES AND ONLY MALES HAVE HORNS. THE HORNS ARE LONG, SPIRAL-STRUCTURED AND ARE VAGUELY LYRE-SHAPED.

SPRINGBOK



**THE SPRINGBOK IS THE NATIONAL ANIMAL OF SOUTH AFRICA.
THE COMMON NAME "SPRINGBOK" COMES FROM THE AFRIKAANS WORDS SPRING ("JUMP") AND BOK ("ANTELOPE" OR "GOAT")
WHEN THE ANIMAL IS EXCITED, THE CLUMP OF WHITE HAIR IS RAISED. SOMETIMES A SPRINGBOK JUMPS INTO THE AIR WITH ITS BACK ARCHED AND ITS LEGS HELD TOGETHER. IT CAN JUMP MORE THAN 10 FEET (3 METERS) STRAIGHT UP**

BLACKBUCK



THE HORNS – WHICH FORM A LARGE “V-SHAPE” – ARE USED BY MALES TO SPAR WITH OTHER MALES AND DEFEND THEIR TERRITORY. LIKE OTHER ANTELOPE

BLACKBUCK ARE QUITE WELL KNOWN FOR THEIR SPEED (70 MILES PER HOUR)

OSTRICH



OSTRICHES CAN'T FLY, BUT NO BIRDS CAN MATCH THEIR SPEED ON LAND. OSTRICHES ARE THE FASTEST RUNNING BIRDS IN THE WORLD! THEY CAN COVER MORE THAN 10 FEET IN A SINGLE STRIDE

LIFESPAN (IN WILD): 30-40 YEARS, WEIGHT: MORE THAN 150KG, BODY LENGTH: 2.1-2.7M TALL, TOP SPEED: 70KM/H

ZEBRA



**ZEBRAS USE THEIR STRIPES TO CAMOUFLAGE THEMSELVES IN TALL GRASSES.
ZEBRAS FIGHT OFF PREDATORS BY KICKING AND BITING.
THEY ARE CLASSIFIED AS ENDANGERED, THEY CAN RUN UP TO 65KM PER HOUR, ZEBRAS STRIPES ARE
UNIQUE LIKE FINGERPRINTS. ...
NEW-BORN FOALS CAN STAND AFTER SIX MINUTES**

ADDAX



ADDAX ARE ONE OF THE FEW SPECIES WHERE MALE AND FEMALES HAVE HORNS OF THE SAME SIZE. THESE DESERT ANTELOPES' COAT COLOR CHANGES FROM DARK GRAYISH-BROWN IN WINTER TO WHITE IN THE SUMMER, AN EFFICIENT METHOD OF MAINTAINING BODY TEMPERATURES.

THE ADDAX MAINLY EATS GRASSES AND LEAVES OF ANY AVAILABLE SHRUBS, LEGUMINOUS HERBS AND BUSHES. THEY ARE WELL-ADAPTED TO EXIST IN THEIR DESERT HABITAT, AS THEY CAN LIVE WITHOUT WATER FOR LONG PERIODS OF TIME. ADDAX FORM HERDS OF FIVE TO 20 MEMBERS, CONSISTING OF BOTH MALES AND FEMALES. THEY ARE LED BY THE OLDEST FEMALE.

ARABIAN ORYX



ARABIAN ORYX ARE DESERT ANTELOPES THAT ARE PERFECTLY MADE FOR LIVING IN THE ARABIAN PENINSULA. THEY ARE NO LONGER EXTINCT IN THE WILD AND ARE HERBIVORES THAT ONLY EAT PLANTS. THEY HAVE WHITE COATS TO HELP THEM STAY COOL IN THE HOT SUN, AND THEIR WIDE FEET ARE AN ADAPTATION THAT HELP THEM STAY ON TOP OF THE SAND. THE ARABIAN ORYX WAS DECLARED EXTINCT IN THE WILD IN 1972.

ELAND



THE COW-LIKE ELAND IS THE WORLD'S LARGEST ANTELOPE. HOWEVER, IT HAS THE ENDURANCE TO MAINTAIN A TROT INDEFINITELY AND CAN JUMP A 1.5 METER (4 FEET) FENCE FROM A STANDSTILL. BOTH MALES AND FEMALES HAVE HORNS THAT SPIRAL TIGHTLY, THOUGH FEMALE HORNS TEND TO BE LONGER AND THINNER.

THE ELAND IS THE LARGEST AFRICAN BOVID, BUT THE SLOWEST ANTELOPE. IT CAN ONLY RUN ABOUT 40 KPH

RHIM GAZELLE



RHIM GAZELLE ALSO CALLED SAND GAZELLE, WIDE HOOVES ALLOW FOR TRAVEL IN THE DESERT SAND. PALE COAT COLOR HELPS TO REFLECT THE SUN TO PREVENT OVERHEATING.

IT IS THE PALEST OF THE GAZELLES, AND WELL-ADAPTED TO DESERT LIFE IN MANY WAYS. ITS UPPER PARTS ARE PALE BUFF OR CREAM AND THE LIMBS AND UNDER PARTS ARE WHITE OR PALE BUFF. THE HORNS ON THE MALE ARE SLENDER AND SLIGHTLY S-SHAPED; THOSE OF THE FEMALE ARE EVEN THINNER, LIGHTER, AND NEARLY STRAIGHT.

WILDLIFE VISITOR'S CENTRE



AFTER THE SAFARI GUESTS WILL BE TRANSPORTED TO THE WILDLIFE VISITORS CENTRE WHERE CLOSE UP ENCOUNTERS WITH A VARIETY OF ANIMALS (BIRDS, PARROTS, PORCUPINE, HEDGEHOG, WOLF, HYENA, BABOONS AND OTHERS) WILL OCCUR.

THE VISIT TO THE WILDLIFE VISITORS CENTRE WILL TAKE APPROXIMATELY ONE HOUR.

BABOONS



**THE BOND BETWEEN MOTHER AND INFANT BABOON IS VERY SPECIAL. ...
BABOONS ARE VERY STRONG ANIMALS AND HAVE SHARP CANINE TEETH SIMILAR IN LENGTH TO LIONS. ...
THE BABOON WAS REVERED IN ANCIENT EGYPTIAN CULTURE, BEING ADMIRER FOR ITS INTELLIGENCE. ...
BABOONS HAVE CO-EXISTED WITH HUMAN ANCESTORS FOR MANY MILLIONS OF YEARS.**

PORCUPINE



**PORCUPINES ARE COVERED IN ABOUT 30,000 QUILLS. THEY CANNOT THROW OR SHOOT THEIR QUILLS. ...
WHILE PORCUPINES SPEND MOST OF THE TIME ON THE GROUND, THEY ARE GOOD CLIMBERS AND REGULARLY CLIMB
TREES IN SEARCH OF FOOD AND OCCASIONALLY EVEN BUILD NESTS IN TREES. THEY ARE ALSO GOOD SWIMMERS.
THE WORD PORCUPINE MEANS 'THORN PIG' ...
THERE ARE TWO DISTINCT FAMILIES OF PORCUPINES. ...
THEY HAVE LONG LIFE SPANS FOR RODENTS**

MINIATURE GOATS



THEY MAKE A GOOD IMPRESSION ON ZOO VISITORS WHO PET THEM. MALES PRODUCE A STRONG, MUSKY ODOR TO ATTRACT FEMALES, ESPECIALLY DURING BREEDING SEASON. THEIR SCENT GLAND IS ON THE CROWN OF THEIR HEAD. FEMALES AND NEUTERED MALES ARE ODOR-FREE.

PYGMY GOATS ARE PREGNANT FOR BETWEEN 145 AND 153 DAYS. GOATS GIVE BIRTH TO ONE OR TWO KIDS; EACH WEIGHS ABOUT TWO TO FOUR POUNDS AT BIRTH, BUT CAN STAND AND NURSE WITHIN MINUTES. THEY CAN RUN AND JUMP WITHIN FOUR HOURS OF BIRTH.

CROCODILES



**THEY ARE THE LARGEST REPTILES ON EARTH. ...
CROCODILES REALLY DO PRODUCE TEARS. ...

KOI FISH

MOST KOI FISH OUTLIVE THEIR OWNERS, HAVING A LIFESPAN OF 200+ YEARS. ...

PATAGONIAN MARA



PATAGONIAN MARAS MAY WALK, HOP IN A RABBIT-LIKE FASHION, GALLOP OR STOT — A UNIQUE FORM OF LOCOMOTION TYPICALLY EXHIBITED BY UNGULATES, WHERE THE ANIMAL BOUNCES ON ALL FOURS. THESE MARAS TRAVEL IN MATED PAIRS, WITH THE MALE AGGRESSIVELY PROTECTING HIS MATE FROM RIVALS AND PREDATORS.

TORTOISE BIG



**TORTOISES ARE ANCIENT. ...
THEY CAN LIVE A VERY LONG TIME. ...

A GROUP OF TORTOISES IS CALLED A CREEP. ...
THE SCALES ON A TORTOISE SHELL ARE KNOWN AS SCUTES. ...
THE COLOR OF THE SHELL INDICATES ORIGIN.**

TORTOISE SMALL



TORTOISES LAY EGGS AND FEMALES WILL BURY THEIR EGGS TO KEEP THEM SAFE FROM PREDATORS. A TORTOISE CALLED JONATHON IS CURRENTLY THE LONGEST-LIVING LAND ANIMAL IN THE WORLD, AT 190 YEARS OLD! TORTOISES HAVE EXISTED FOR OVER 55 MILLION YEARS. A GROUP OF TORTOISES IS CALLED A CREEP

TORTOISES ARE UNIQUE ANIMALS THAT HAVE A SHELL, WHICH IS THEIR EXOSKELETON, ON THE OUTSIDE OF THEIR BODIES. THIS EXOSKELETON GIVES ITS BODY ITS HARD SHAPE THAT PROTECTS IT. IN ADDITION, THEY HAVE AN ENDOSKELETON, OR INNER SKELETON, THAT GIVES THE INSIDE OF ITS BODY STRUCTURE AND SUPPORT TOO

SNAKES



THEY HAVE A VERY BIG FAMILY. ...

THEY ARE “SOLAR-POWERED” AND RELY FULLY ON EXTERNAL HEAT OR LIGHT SOURCES. ...

NOT ALL SNAKES LAY EGGS. ...

SNAKES DON'T HAVE EYELIDS. ...

OWL



THEIR CLOSE VISION IS NOT AS CLEAR WHICH MAKES THEM FARSIGHTED. OWLS CAN ROTATE THEIR NECKS AT 270 DEGREES, 135 DEGREES ON EITHER SIDE. AN OWL HAS 3 EYELIDS- ONE FOR BLINKING, ONE FOR SLEEPING AND ONE FOR KEEPING ITS EYES CLEAN. OWLS ARE CARNIVORES. OWLS EVOLVED SENSES AND PHYSICAL ATTRIBUTES PERFECTLY ADAPTED TO THEIR NIGHT HUNTER LIFESTYLES, AND PRESUMABLY HAD NO NEED FOR EXTRA ABILITIES SUCH AS CURIOSITY, WHICH CAN RESULT IN GREATER INTELLIGENCE. TRYING TO COMPARE THE INTELLIGENCE OF OWLS WITH THAT OF OTHER BIRDS IS A BIT LIKE COMPARING CATS WITH DOGS

EAGLE



THE FEMALE IS LARGER THAN THE MALE. THE DISTINCTIVE WHITE HEAD AND TAIL FEATHERS APPEAR WHEN THE EAGLES MATURE AT 4 OR 5 YEARS OLD. BALD EAGLES ARE BELIEVED TO LIVE 30 YEARS OR LONGER IN THE WILD. THEY MATE FOR LIFE, BUILDING HUGE NESTS IN THE TOPS OF LARGE TREES NEAR RIVERS, LAKES, AND OTHER WETLANDS.

THEY HAVE AMAZING EYESIGHT. A HUMAN WITH PERFECT EYESIGHT HAS 20/20 VISION.

THEY DON'T NEED TO EAT EVERY DAY.

THEY'RE MOSTLY FEATHERS, THEY AREN'T BALD!

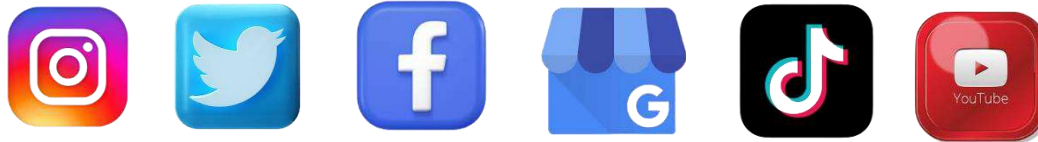
